Trophies

Errislannan Perpetual Trophy

To be awarded to the horse/pony holding the most points overall, Studbook or Sport Register.

Blandings Connemara Stud Perpetual Trophy

To be awarded to a Studbook registered pony holding the most points overall.

Ridgeway Kilkelly Memorial Perpetual Trophy

To be awarded to a sport register horse/ pony holding the most points overall.

Waterfall Enniskillen Memorial Perpetual Trophy

To be awarded to the horse/pony that has attended the most Pony Club rallies.

Scarteen Perpetual Trophy

To be awarded to the Stallion that has collectively gained the most points over all from horses/ponies entered with said Stallion as the direct sire.

Ridgeway Stud Perpetual Trophy

To be awarded to the breeder that has collectively gained the most points over all from horses/ponies entered under their stud prefix.

Terms & Conditions

1. All Ponies/Hacks must be registered with the Connemara Pony Society of New Zealand Incorporated and must display registration number on the entry form.
2. The Performance Trophy Competition will run from the 1st August 2016 to the 31st July 2017.
3. Competition cards must be signed by any official from each event and returned by the 10th August 2017 to the convener, Courtney Mullen @ media.cpsnz@gmail.com or via post.
4. The Performance Competition is for the Pony/Hack not the Rider/Driver or Handler. Any questions please contact the convener.
5. Any Pony/Hack sold/leased during the competition year may have any points gained before the sale/lease, transferred with the change of ownership/lease. The Vendor must notify the Convener of the sale/lease, at the time of ownership/lease change. Change of ownership/lease must also be recorded with the CPSNZ as appropriate.
6. Open Competition means entry is not restricted by membership of any specific group or club. In other words, any person may enter the competition subject to the rules of that competition. For example an ESNZ One day horse trial.
7. Closed Competition means entry of competition is restricted by membership of a club, i.e. In house/closed Pony Club Cup/Ribbon Day, a restricted to members only event.
8. If you are unable to get your card signed on the day, you may have this signed later or provide evidence of your placings, for example published results - these will need to be screen shot or printed off and sent in with your entries.

Sections available for Entry

Place getters of each section to be awarded a rosette and prizes – prizes to be confirmed and will be sent out and awarded in due course once all entries are received and tallied.

Eventing (Pony club & ENSZ)

Showing - R.A.S in-hand & ridden shows to be allocated Open Points, Pony club ribbon days etc. to be allocated Ribbon day points with no more than 10 classes to be recorded in one day.

Point Allocation

Points will be allocated to Horses/ Ponies who place 1st – 6th in open/closed or ribbon day competition. Points gained in closed/in house competition will half of that gained for the same placing gained in open competition. Refer to rules 6 & 7 for clarification. No Rider Class placings to be recorded.

- gained on the live completion of an organised activity/competition i.e. hunt, pony club rally, trek, endurance ride, ODE, Show day, Jump day, dressage day, adult rally etc. These need to be signed off via head coach, hunt master, official etc. (Note may be used for maximum of 10 classes at a ribbon day/R.A.S show in which classes the Pony/Horse did not place)

Team Selection = 60

- Individual placings within a team competition to be recorded as per open competition and points awarded on top of this.

* * Any horses/ponies that win age group/level or else wise championship title are eligible to record this down with championship points. i.e. Waikato level 2 pony dressage champ.
