## **1. POLICY**

- 1.1. This document contains all Studbook and Sport Register Policy and Regulations and replaces all previous regulations, including statements of policy on forms and certificates.
- 1.2. A pony SHALL be registered once it has met the criteria for the Studbook or Sports Register.
- 1.3. The accompanying “Notes to the Regulations” provide additional information and shall not make a pony ineligible for entry into the Studbook or Sports Register.
- 1.4. Applications for registration in the Studbook and Sports Register will be accepted from members of CPSNZ and non-members. Fees will be higher for non-members.

## **2. STUDBOOK**

- 2.1. The CPSNZ Studbook regulations align with the Connemara Pony Breeders Society (CPBS) Principles and breed standard.
- 2.2. To qualify for entry into the Studbook a pony must satisfy the criteria for the relevant section listed below in sections 2.3 to 2.5.

### **The Stud book is divided into three (3) classes:**

#### **2.3. Studbook Class 1**

- 2.3.1. Class 1 contains entire males that are a minimum of three years of age and mares and geldings that are a minimum of two years of age. These ponies must meet all of the following criteria to qualify for Class 1.
- 2.3.2. Both parents must be entered in the CPSNZ Studbook or an ICCPS member society Studbook.
- 2.3.3. Measure 128cms to 148cms inclusive without shoes.
- 2.3.4. Pass a visual breed inspection against the breed standard by achieving the minimum marking standard for Class 1. Minimum score of 8 in each section for stallions. Minimum score of 7 in each section for mares/geldings.
- 2.3.5. Has passed the CPSNZ or ICCPS member society veterinary inspection.
- 2.3.6. DNA profile and parent verification is filed with EPAGSC, Massey University and the CPSNZ Registrar.
- 2.3.7. Brand details and/or microchip details are recorded with CPSNZ Registrar.
- 2.3.8. Hoof Wall Separation Disease (HWSD) testing is a requirement for all foals born after 31 July 2018. This requirement is exempt if both parents have been HWSD tested N/N and these records are on file with the CPSNZ Registrar.
- 2.3.9. Appropriate fee paid

#### **2.4. Studbook Class 2**

- 2.4.1. Class 2 contains entire males that are a minimum of three years of age, and mares and geldings that are a minimum of two years of age. These ponies must meet all of the following criteria to qualify for Class 2:
- 2.4.2. Both parents must be entered in the CPSNZ Studbook or an ICCPS member society Studbook.
- 2.4.3. Ponies that measure any height (includes those that may pass the visual breed inspection at class 1 levels but height measures under 128cms or over 148cms, without shoes).

- 2.4.4. Pass a visual breed inspection against the breed standard by achieving the minimum marking standard for Class 2. Minimum score of 6 in each section for stallions. Minimum score of 5 in each section for mares/geldings.
- 2.4.5. Has passed the CPSNZ or ICCPS member society veterinary inspection.
- 2.4.6. DNA profile and parent verification is filed with EPAGSC, Massey University and the CPSNZ Registrar.
- 2.4.7. Brand details and/or microchip details are recorded with CPSNZ Registrar.
- 2.4.8. Hoof Wall Separation Disease (HWSD) testing is a requirement for all foals born after 31 July 2018. This requirement is exempt if both parents have been HWSD tested N/N and these records are on file with the CPSNZ Registrar
- 2.4.9. Appropriate fee paid

## 2.5. Studbook Class 3

Includes ponies that have met criteria for entry into the studbook and those who may have been presented for visual breed inspection but not met additional criteria to enter Class 1 or 2. A pony that is not presented for visual breed inspection will remain in Class 3.

- 2.5.1. Class 3 contains entire males, mares, and geldings of any age that meet all of the following criteria to qualify for Class 3:
- 2.5.2. Both parents must be entered in the CPSNZ Studbook or an ICCPS member society Studbook.
- 2.5.3. Brand details and/or microchip details are recorded with CPSNZ Registrar.
- 2.5.4. DNA profile and parent verification is filed with EPAGSC, Massey University and the CPSNZ Registrar.  
**Exemption:** Geldings are exempt if they have not sired a purebred foal and notification of gelding has been submitted to the CPSNZ Registrar on the appropriate CPSNZ foal identity record or gelding notification form with a DNA hair sample that will be retained by the CPSNZ Registrar. If a gelding has sired a purebred foal then the registration fee will be that for an entire male to cover DNA parent verification and HWSD testing.
- 2.5.5. Hoof Wall Separation Disease (HWSD) testing is a requirement for all foals born after 31 July 2018. This requirement is exempt if both parents have been HWSD tested N/N and these records are on file with the CPSNZ Registrar.  
**Exemption:** Geldings are exempt if they have not sired a purebred foal and notification of gelding has been submitted to the CPSNZ Registrar on the appropriate CPSNZ foal identity record or gelding notification form with a DNA hair sample that will be retained by the CPSNZ Registrar. If a gelding has sired a purebred foal then the registration fee will be that for an entire male to cover DNA parent verification and HWSD testing.
- 2.5.6. Appropriate fee paid

## 2.6. Studbook Eligible Foals

The progeny of two Studbook parents entered in the CPSNZ Studbook or an ICCPS Studbook. Please note a foal identity record is not a registration with CPSNZ.

- 2.6.1. Studbook eligible foals will have their CPSNZ foal identity record recorded with the society when Page 1 and 2 of the foal identity record form is completed and submitted to the CPSNZ Registrar.

## 2.7. Studbook Passport

- 2.7.1. Studbook ponies shall receive a Studbook passport issued by the CPSNZ Registrar including:
  - Registered Name (and, where advised, names registered with other

- organisations such as ESNZ)
- Unique Life Registration Number
- Name of Breeder, Owners and Lessees
- Date of birth, colour (birth coat and adult coat), sex, markings, date of issue.
- Description of pony – horse drawings with markings, or digital photographs of each side, rear and front views.
- 4 generation pedigree.
- Brands and/or Micro-chip details
- DNA profile / parent verification report (where applicable).
- Date passed veterinary inspection (where applicable)
- Date passed visual breed inspection (where applicable)
- Date of gelding (where applicable)
- HWSD test results (where applicable)
- Genetic tests (where applicable)

### **3. SPORTS REGISTER**

Ponies are eligible for the Sports Register if the following criteria are met:

- 3.1. One (1) parent is registered in the CPSNZ Studbook or an ICCPS member society Studbook;
  - or
  - One (1) grandparent is registered in the CPSNZ Studbook or an ICCPS member society Studbook, and one parent is recorded in the CPSNZ Sports Register.
- 3.1.1. A completed Application for foal identity record is received by the CPSNZ Registrar.
- 3.1.2. Appropriate fee is paid.
- 3.2. Sports Register ponies shall receive a Sports Register passport issued by the CPSNZ Registrar including:
  - Registered Name (and, where advised, names registered with other organisations such as ESNZ)
  - Unique Life Registration Number
  - Name of Breeder, Owners and Lessees
  - Date of birth, colour (birth coat and adult coat), sex, markings and date of issue.
  - Description of pony – horse drawings with markings, or digital images of each side, rear and front views.
  - Brands and/or Micro-chip details, if provided.
  - Date of gelding (where applicable)
  - Genetic Tests (where applicable)

### **4. DNA GENOTYPING AND PARENT VERIFICATION**

- 4.1. CPSNZ shall not use or approve the use of any DNA sample for any purpose other than identification or parent verification and Hoof Wall Separation Disease (HWSD) without express consent of the recorded owner of the pony.
- 4.2. Once a DNA sample is submitted to or through CPSNZ the sample and results become the property of the CPSNZ.
- 4.3. Access to DNA results may be available through the CPSNZ upon application to the Committee.
- 4.4. See Notes to the Regulations for further information.

## **5. BRANDING**

- 5.1. The CPSNZ Registrar shall keep a register of brands used by breeders.
- 5.2. Branding notification to be completed on foal identity record form, for older ponies branding notification forms are available from the CPSNZ Registrar and on the CPSNZ website.
- 5.3. Send completed foal identity record Page 3 or branding notification form and/or Sports Register passport to the CPSNZ Registrar for recording.
- 5.4. See Notes to the Regulations for further information.
- 5.5. The CPSNZ shamrock brand is available for use on Studbook eligible foals and Studbook ponies, subject to the following conditions:
  - 5.5.1. Pony has been DNA parent verified
  - 5.5.2. Left (or near) shoulder: CPSNZ Shamrock brand or CPSNZ Shamrock brand and stud brand
  - 5.5.3. Right (or off) shoulder: Individual number (allocated by CPSNZ Registrar) above the last number of the pony's year of birth
  - 5.5.4. Appropriate fee paid

## **6. MICROCHIPPING**

- 6.1. Microchipping to be recorded on foal identity record page 3, for older ponies Notification of microchipping forms are available from the CPSNZ Registrar and on the CPSNZ website.
- 6.2. Send completed foal identity record Page 3 or Microchipping notification form and Sports register passport to the CPSNZ Registrar for recording.
- 6.3. Reading of micro-chips is at owner's expense.
- 6.4. See Notes to the Regulations for further information.

## **7. CPSNZ VETERINARY INSPECTION**

The CPSNZ Veterinary inspection is not compulsory for entry into the Studbook Class 3, but is a requirement for Entry into Class 1 & 2.

- 7.1. Ponies must be a minimum of two (2) years of age to be eligible for veterinary inspection.
- 7.2. The CPSNZ veterinary inspection forms are available from the CPSNZ Registrar or the CPSNZ website. There are separate forms for stallions and mares/geldings.
- 7.3. Send completed CPSNZ veterinary inspection form and foal identity record or Passport to the CPSNZ Registrar for recording and updating.
- 7.4. There is no time limit between veterinary inspection and visual breed inspection.
- 7.5. See Notes to the Regulations for further information.

## **8. VISUAL BREED INSPECTION**

The CPSNZ visual breed inspection is not compulsory for entry into the Studbook Class 3, but is a requirement for Entry into Studbook Class 1 & 2.

- 8.1. Entire males are eligible for visual breed inspection from three (3) years of age.
- 8.2. Mares and geldings are eligible for visual breed inspection from two (2) years of age.
- 8.3. The owner, leasee or agent for the pony must contact the CPSNZ Registrar to initiate the visual breed inspection process; and provide the following:
  - 8.3.1. Visual breed inspection fee

- 8.3.2. Studbook passport
- 8.3.3. Completed veterinary inspection form, if not already provided.

## **9. IMPORTED PONIES**

- 9.1. A copy of the pony's Passport or registration document must be filed with the CPSNZ Registrar.
- 9.2. The owner shall arrange for a copy of the pony's DNA profile to be filed with EPAGSC, Massey University and the CPSNZ Registrar. See Notes to the Regulations for further assistance.
- 9.3. The owner of an 'imported in utero' foal shall arrange for a copy of the sire's DNA profile to be filed with EPAGSC, Massey University.
- 9.4. Microchips must be read by a vet on arrival in NZ at owner's expense and must match those on the pony's passport.
- 9.5. Ponies will remain on their country of origin passport.

## **10. RECORDS OF MATING**

- 10.1. Records of mating's (natural or artificial insemination) to be entered on the Application for foal identity record.
- 10.2. CPSNZ requests a copy of each seasons mating records to be sent to the Registrar
- 10.3. Appropriate sections of Application for foal identity record to be provided to the mare owner or leasee to assist in the registration of resulting progeny.
- 10.4. CPSNZ will make available template Records of service forms and Application for foal identity record forms to owners.
- 10.5. Application for foal identity record forms must be signed by the person supervising the mating (natural or artificial insemination) and/or in charge of the stallion.
- 10.6. For Artificial insemination (AI) complete the appropriate section of CPSNZ Application for foal identity record, and be provided to the Registrar. A copy of technician or veterinarian documents confirming artificial insemination can be submitted if foal identity record unable to be completed at the time.

## **11. STUD PREFIXES & SUFFIXES**

- 11.1. All breeders must have a single word Stud Prefix approved by the committee of the society in order to register Studbook ponies with the Society.
- 11.2. The name of the pony, combined Stud Prefix and pony name, must be less than 30 characters including spaces.
- 11.3. Sports Register ponies may be registered without a stud prefix.
- 11.4. The committee must approve any stud prefix before use, and reserves the right to reject any prefix, which is the same as, or similar to, any other approved Connemara prefix in NZ or overseas, or is unsuitable on any other grounds. Applications for recording of Stud prefix must be made on the official form, and sent to the Registrar with the current fee.
- 11.5. Owners may use their own Prefix as a Suffix in cases where they are not the breeder of the pony, but pay all costs to qualify for entry into Studbook or Sports Register.

## **12. TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP**

- 12.1. The Registrar will record changes of ownership on the Studbook/Sport Register Passport or foal identity record on receipt of:

- 12.1.1. Studbook/Sport Register Passport or foal identity record, and
- 12.1.2. CPSNZ change of ownership/lease notification form (available in hard copy or electronically), and
- 12.1.3. Appropriate fee paid (payable by vendor).

### **13. LEASES**

- 13.1. CPSNZ recommends leases of registered ponies for breeding or competitive purposes are notified to the Registrar.
- 13.2. Lease notifications can be made by providing the pony Studbook/Sport Register Passport or foal identity record to the CPSNZ Registrar with
  - 13.2.1. CPSNZ change of ownership/Lease notification form or copy of the lease document, and
  - 13.2.2. Appropriate fee paid
- 13.3. The Registrar will record the lease on the Studbook/Sport Register Passport or foal identity record and send a copy to the leasee. The original passport or record will be returned to the owner.
- 13.4. At completion of the lease, the leasee will advise the Registrar, who will confirm with the owner. The owner will then record the lease termination date on the pony's passport or record.

### **14. NOTIFICATION OF DEATH**

- 14.1. Please notify the Registrar in writing of a pony's death as soon as practicable.

### **15. OTHER MATTERS**

- 15.1. A pony's owner may at any time request from the Registrar a copy of all information held regarding that pony. The owner may request, in writing, correction of any information held by CPSNZ, subject to suitable verification.
- 15.2. Any issue concerning the Studbook and Sports Register in these Regulations may be referred to the Committee for a decision.
- 15.3. The person bringing the issue to the Committee shall be provided with information and opinions gathered by the Committee in writing and be given the opportunity to provide a reply.
- 15.4. The Committee will consult with the Registrar and person bringing the issue to the Committee. The Committee may seek information and opinions from any other person or organisation that might assist in decision making.
- 15.5. The Committee shall provide their decision in writing.

### **16. CHARACTERISTICS OF THE BREED**

**Type:** Compact, well balanced riding type with good depth and substance and good heart room, standing on short legs, covering a lot of ground. Good temperament, hardiness, staying power, intelligence, soundness, surefootedness, with jumping ability.

**Height:** 128cms to 148cms inclusive.

**Colour:** Grey, Black, Bay, Brown, Dun may also be known as buckskin, Palomino, Dark-Eyed Cream, Blue Eyed cream with occasional Roans and Chestnuts.

**Head:** Well-balanced head of medium length with good width between large kindly eyes. Pony

ears, well-defined cheekbone, jaw relatively deep but not coarse.

**Front:** Head well set onto neck. Crest should not be over-developed. Neck not set on too low. Good length of rein. Well-defined withers, good sloping shoulders.

**Body:** Body should be deep, with strong back, some length permissible, but should be well ribbed up with strong loins.

**Limbs:** Good length and strength in forearm, well-defined knees and short cannon with flat bone measuring 18cms to 21cms. Elbows should be free. Pasterns of medium length, feet well shaped, of medium size, hard and level.

**Hind:** Strong muscular with some length, well developed second thigh (gaskin) and strong low set hocks.

**Movement:** Free easy and true, without undue knee action, but active and covering the ground.

## 18. NOTES TO THE REGULATIONS

- If an owner chooses to update a pony registration certificate (issued before 15 March 2013) to a passport then the replacement registration fee applies.
- Old registration certificates will automatically be updated to the new passport at time of change



of ownership.

## **Transition of ponies previously registered with CPSNZ**

### **Prior to 15 March 2013**

- Section 1 Studbook Stallions become Studbook Class 1 Stallions
- Section 2 Studbook Mares that have passed visual breed inspection become Studbook Class 1 Mares
- Section 2 Studbook Mares become Studbook Class 3 Mares
- Section 3 Studbook Geldings become Studbook Class 3 Geldings
- Section 4 Temporary Recorded Ponies:  
Meeting the Studbook eligible foals criteria in 2.6, become foal identity recorded.

Meeting the Studbook criteria in 2.5 become Studbook Class 3 ponies and will be issued a Studbook Passport if the owner sends the foal registration certificate to the Registrar.

Meeting the criteria 3.1, become Sports Register ponies. A Sports Register Passport will be issued if the owner sends the foal registration certificate to the Registrar.

- Sport Register Section 1 Stallions meeting the criteria in 2.5 become Studbook Class 3 Stallions.
- Ponies registered in Sports Register where new information is able to be provided to the CPSNZ committee may be brought to the committee's attention for review, see Other Matters.

### **Between 15 March 2013 – 1 August 2018**

- A Studbook Pony which had the placeholder of 0 in their passport becomes a Studbook Class 3 pony. The Passport will be updated at the next change of ownership or lease.

### **General Recommendations**

- That records of mating are returned to the Registrar as soon as practicable each year.
- That transfers of ownership are notified to the Registrar as soon as possible after sale.

### **DNA Genotyping and Parent Verification**

- CPSNZ provides to its members, testing access to the Equine Parentage and Genetic Services Centre (EPAGSC), Massey University.
- Please send 20-30 pulled hairs including root bulb from the pony (mane or tail) plus foal identity record (pony details) to the Registrar.
- Registrar will send sample and submission form for testing to EPAGSC after confirmed payment of the current fee.
- A copy of the resulting report will be sent to the CPSNZ Registrar who will forward a copy of the report to the submitter and retain a copy for CPSNZ database and registration records.
- DNA profiles for non-resident semen donors, sires of imported in utero foals, and embryo donors are required to DNA parent verify progeny prior to entry into the Studbook. The owner of the pony to be registered in the CPSNZ Studbook must arrange for a copy of the pony's parent's DNA profile(s) to be filed with EPAGSC, Massey University and the CPSNZ Registrar. The protocol for accessing DNA profiles depends on the country of origin and may require contacting the Connemara Society in the country of origin or pony's parents owner or the laboratory that carried out the DNA test for the pony. Contact the CPSNZ Registrar for advice.

### **Hoof Wall Separation Disease (HWSD)**

- HWSD testing is a requirement for all foals born after 31 July 2018. This requirement is exempt if both parents have been HWSD tested N/N and these records are on file with the CPSNZ Registrar.

## **Branding**

- CPSNZ recommends purebred ponies are branded and/or micro-chipped before 18 months of age.
- CPSNZ recommends members register their stud brand with both NZ Thoroughbred Breeders Association (no cost) and CPSNZ (fee applies, contact the Registrar).
- There is a section on the foal identity record for recording branding. Otherwise branding notification forms are available from the CPSNZ Registrar, and on the website.
- Send completed branding notification information to the CPSNZ Registrar for recording (Either foal identity record or branding notification form).
- Ponies should be branded in this format:
  - Left (or near) shoulder: Stud brand or vet brand or TB brand.
  - Right (or off) shoulder: Individual herd number above the last number of the pony's year of birth.

## **Microchipping**

- CPSNZ recommends purebred ponies are branded and/or micro-chipped before 18 months of age.
- There is a section on the foal identity record for recording microchipping. Otherwise microchipping notification forms are available from the CPSNZ Registrar, and on the website.
- Send completed microchipping notification information to the CPSNZ Registrar for recording (Either foal identity record or microchipping notification form).
- Reading of microchips is at owner's expense.

## **Visual breed inspections**

- Visual breed inspections may not be held every year.
- That while age is considered as per the season a pony is born, the maturity of the animal should be considered first before putting forward for visual breed inspection.
- Inspectors should give constructive feedback about the pony to the owner, leasee or agent. With the permission of the owner, leasee or agent, inspectors may discuss with any audience the qualities of the pony in terms of the breed standard.
- The CPSNZ Committee will appoint three (3) inspectors for entire male inspections and two (2) inspectors for mare/gelding inspections.
- At least one inspector shall be a CPSNZ or ICCPS approved breed inspector.
- Ponies may be re-presented for inspection. Each re-presentation incurs an inspection fee.
- The CPSNZ Committee will arrange the inspection at a mutually convenient time and location.
- Payment of appropriate fee must be paid before visual breed inspection is booked.
- Inspectors will be provided with marking sheets and breed standard.
- Recommended that veterinary inspection be completed before the visual breed inspection, but may be completed after results from visual breed inspection are known.
- Completed inspection forms are returned to the CPSNZ Registrar, who collates the scores, updates the Studbook passport and returns this to the pony owner. Completed inspection forms are retained by the CPSNZ.
  - An independent person may be nominated by the committee to collect completed inspection forms on the day to forward to the registrar, if the registrar is unable to be present.
- Copies of completed visual breed inspection forms are provided to the owner/presenter of the pony after the Registrar has collated the forms.

## **Veterinary inspection**

- May be completed at any time after a pony has reached 2 years of age
- Recommended that entire males are veterinary inspected prior to serving mares.

# Visual breed inspection form Filly/Mare/Gelding



There shall be no conferring between inspectors before marking sheets are returned to the CPSNZ Registrar or appointed independent verifier. Any changes must be initialled. The owner/lease of the pony will be notified of the official result by the CPSNZ Registrar. If during averaging across inspectors a percentage occurs, this shall be rounded up to the nearest whole number.

**Filly/Mare/Gelding:** Minimum Age 2 years. To be Eligible for Class 1, must receive a minimum mark of 7 in each section averaged across two inspectors.

To be eligible for Class two, must receive a minimum mark of 5 in each section.

If a pony receives a mark of 4 or less in any section it will remain in Class 3.
